

FAFSA Received With Estimated Parent Information

We have received your 2021-2022 FAFSA with estimated parent 2019 tax information. In order to process your financial aid application, you will need to update the FAFSA with actual 2018 tax information. To update this information, go to fafsa.ed.gov, log in and indicate that you wish to make a correction to your 2021-2022 FAFSA. If possible, use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to access the data submitted to the IRS. If this option is not presented to you, complete the required information directly from the completed 2019 1040 form. Be sure to change the filing status from “will file” to “completed”. If your parents will not be filing a tax return for the 2019 tax year, make the appropriate updates on the FAFSA and change the filing status to “will not file”.

Please make the required updates to your FAFSA as soon as possible. We will not be able to continue processing your application until the corrected FAFSA is received by our office.
