FROZEN EMBRYO TRANSFER - Approximate Fee Schedule July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024

To assist you in your financial planning, we have prepared an <u>ESTIMATED</u> fee list for the cost of a Frozen Embryo Transfer Cycle. This list does not include all of the cost of office visits, diagnostics tests, laboratory test, and medication for services prior to beginning the cycle. Certain fees may be covered by your insurance carrier, but many services are not covered. You will be billed for services not covered by your insurance carrier.

Unfortunately, most insurance carriers do not cover the cost of IVF/ET. You will be expected to make your pre-payment of the estimated charge(s) prior to the date of the retrieval. If you have any questions, please call 734-763-6295 Option 1 and ask for the Financial Counselor.

PREPARATION:

Depending on the length of time between the last embryo transfer and the frozen transfer, there may need to be a Hysteroscopy or Sonohysterogram and a mock transfer completed prior to the the frozen embryo transfer.
