

#### Victor J. Strecher, PhD, MPH Emcee

Vic is a professor at the University of Michigan School of Public Health and Founder and CEO of Kumanu, Inc. His

latest neuroscience, behavioral, and epidemiologic research; his two books, Life On Purpose and the graphic novel On Purpose; his free massive open online course Finding Purpose and Meaning in Life; and the Purposeful application his business (Kumanu) created are all focused on the importance of developing and maintaining a strong purpose in life.

# Former University of Michigan Men's Basketball Head Coach

Considered to be one of the best basketball minds, John Beilein patrolled the sidelines during his four decades as head coach.

Beilein has compiled a career record of 829-468 (.639) during his 41 years as a collegiate head coach. He has recorded 20-plus win seasons on 23 occasions and has finished with a winning record in 35 seasons, placing him in the top 10 for career victories among active Division I head coaches. In 12 seasons in Ann Arbor, Beilein built the Wolverines into one of the nation's elite programs, taking U-M to a pair of national championship game appearances (2013, '18) while also becoming the winningest coach in school history.
