

COVID-19 Michigan Medicine Clinical Simulation Center Safety Guidelines:

Until further notice, the following guidelines apply to all Michigan Medicine Clinical Simulation Center sessions, courses, and assessments. If you have any concerns, contact Niles Mayrand, Director of Operations for Simulation at nmayrand@umich.edu.

- All persons must wear a face mask. Personal masks including fabric are acceptable. Masks and other PPE will also be available upon arrival.
- No more than 10 people will be allowed in one room, and individuals should follow social distancing recommendation of 6 feet of separation. Room occupancy limitations will be posted on all rooms and monitored for compliance.
- No more than 2 people will be allowed at any skills station and social distancing recommendations of 6 feet of separation should be maintained. Simulations which replicate the clinical setting where the principles of social distancing cannot be followed will mandate adherence to protocols used in the clinical setting (e.g. masks at all times, gloves if personal contact may occur along with immediate post event hand washing).
- Frequent hand hygiene is required for all events. Sanitizer is located at entrance to all rooms and in various common areas of Simulation Center along with hand soap and sinks for hand washing where available.
- All equipment, supplies and furniture utilized for training will be sanitized by the Clinical Simulation Center Staff prior to and after each event. During training that requires multiple rotations of learns, instructors and learners will be responsible for sanitizing equipment prior after each individual training sessions. Cleaning and sanitizing guidelines will be posted at training stations.
- For safety purposes, equipment has been moved or eliminated in order to allow for social distancing. Please do not re-arrange equipment or furniture.
- Instructors will be asked to submit a class roster in advance, and confirm attendance numbers on the day of each event. There will be QR codes that send the instructors to the attendance form from their own device. The QR codes can be made available in advance of an event if the instructor wishes to print them.
- Learners will be asked to check in and out of training sessions. To avoid contact with shared computer stations, this will be done via QR codes from personal devices. QR codes will be posted in the entrance areas of the two CSC locations and, in some instances, at the entrance of rooms being utilized for training. Most phones will open a QR code through the camera feature, however some older phones and or Android phones will require adding a QR code reader app. It is recommended that all instructors and learners familiarize themselves with their particular device prior to their training events.
- Upon arrival and check in, instructors and learners will be directed to a training room.
- Please follow all directions from staff, keep your mask on when directed, wash and sanitize your hands frequently. We ask you limit the personal items you bring to the SimCenter and utilize lockers available in the MedSci II Center, personal items brought to Towsley Center training, should be kept with you at all times.
- Screening at campus entry is required prior to entering the Clinical Simulation Center.
- Instructors and learners should reinforce CDC infection control recommendations, including: remaining home if sick, wearing face masks at all times, maintaining 6 feet of social distance, frequent hand washing, avoiding touching the face, eyes and mouth, avoiding shaking hands or other personal contact frequent cleaning of equipment and surfaces, and covering cough or sneeze with a tissue that is then immediately discarded followed by hand washing.

Instructors are encouraged to send pre-event messages to all learners with the above instructions.
