## Clinical Track Scholarly Contribution

### Clinician-Leader/Administrator (usually overlaps with one of the above pathways.)

My career has revolved around two separate foci – quality of care and the interface between religion and medicine. I have held numerous administrative positions departmentally and institutionally in support of quality. Institutionally, I have been service chief for the Department of Family Medicine since 2010, I was responsible for oversight of our institutional guideline development for five years, I have led the heart failure guideline since 2000, and in 2017 I assumed the role as chair of the Credentials Committee for the University of Michigan. This focus extended nationally in my role on the ACC/AHA UA/NSTEMI guideline team in 2007 and 2011. Also, I have served as an Associate Editor for Physician's First Watch since 2010 in a role that provides relevant and timely news for primary care physicians. I extended this focus on quality as I began global health work in Africa beginning in 2007. This work consisted of teaching on non-communicable diseases and working on the development of primary care in Africa. As well, we sought to help hospitals restructure for the sake of quality and sustainability. Ultimately, instability at the sites limited our impact on system redesign. My experiences in Africa led to introspection about my career and an interest in the interface between religion and medicine. This prompted me, in 2013, to leave my primary care clinic at the University of Michigan and develop a faith-based private clinic in Ann Arbor in 2014. The clinic is built on a dignity, whole person care model. Since inception, the clinic has grown substantially and I continue to see patients there, while maintaining my administrative, teaching, scholarly, and inpatient roles at the University. I am now building an academic career in the area of religion and medicine. Faith-based clinics such as the one I have described, have developed across the country. The Catholic Medical Association (CMA) has an interest in understanding and supporting these efforts and I chair a committee for the CMA designed to support and integrate these efforts. In this role, I have provided consultation to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and have been called to meet with members of Congress to discuss how these efforts fit into a broader primary care model. I also have worked with the national Direct Primary Care coalition around integrating different payment models for these clinics. Finally, I am working with a group consisting of leaders in Catholic healthcare systems and private philanthropy to develop this model of care for the inner cities. Indeed, we have been invited to open such a clinic in Detroit and this is in the planning stages. This will be a test site for clinics being considered in other cities around the country.
