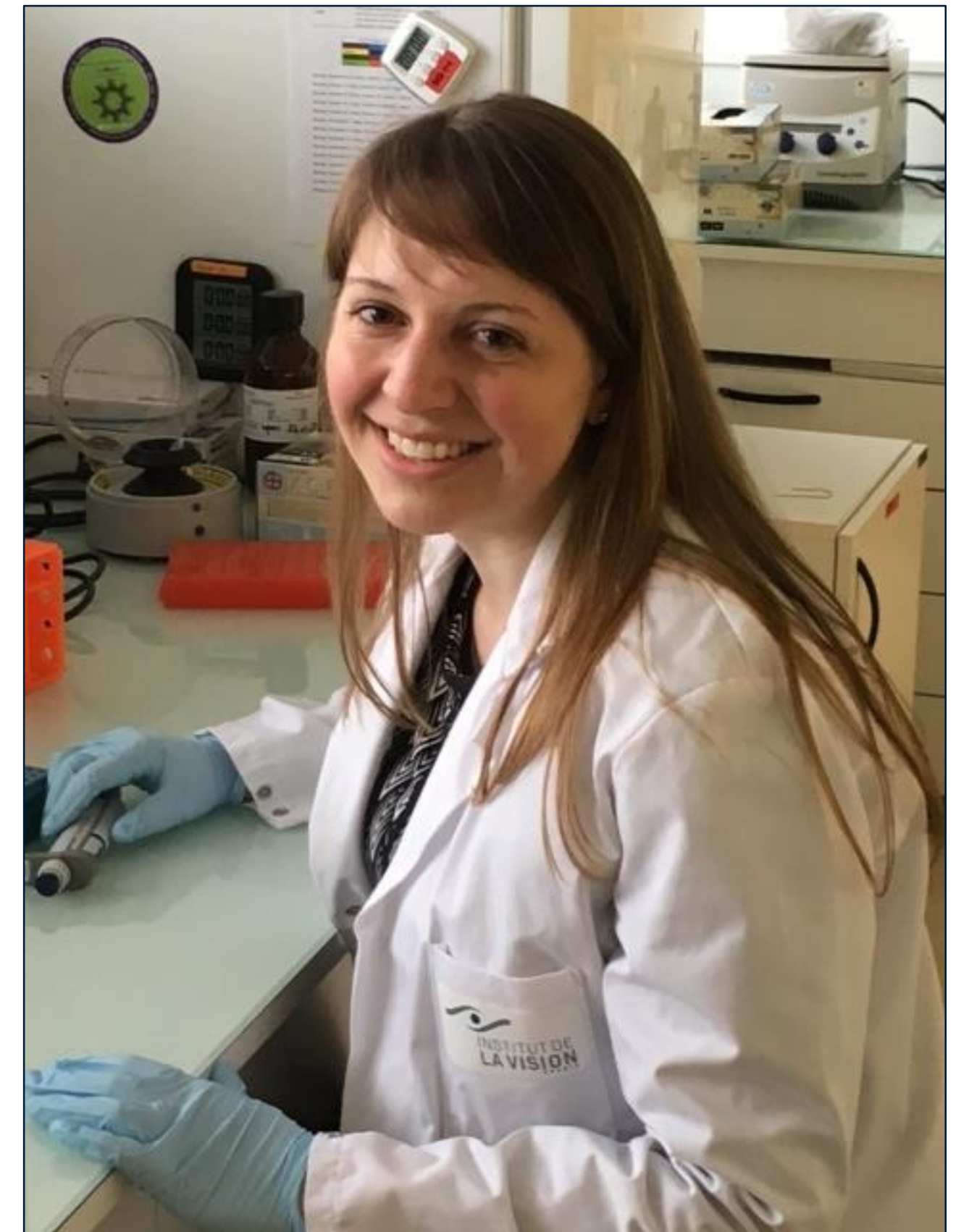




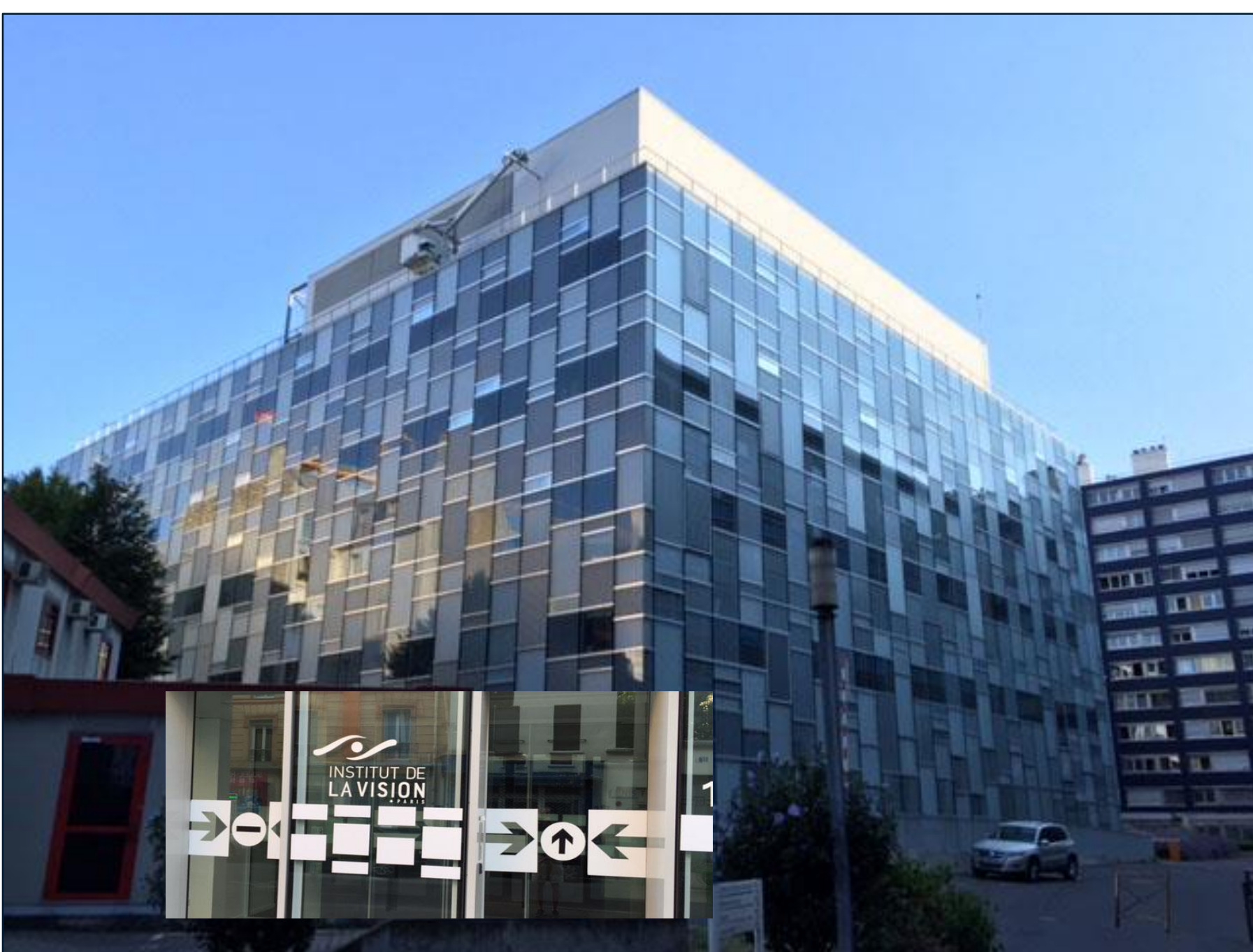

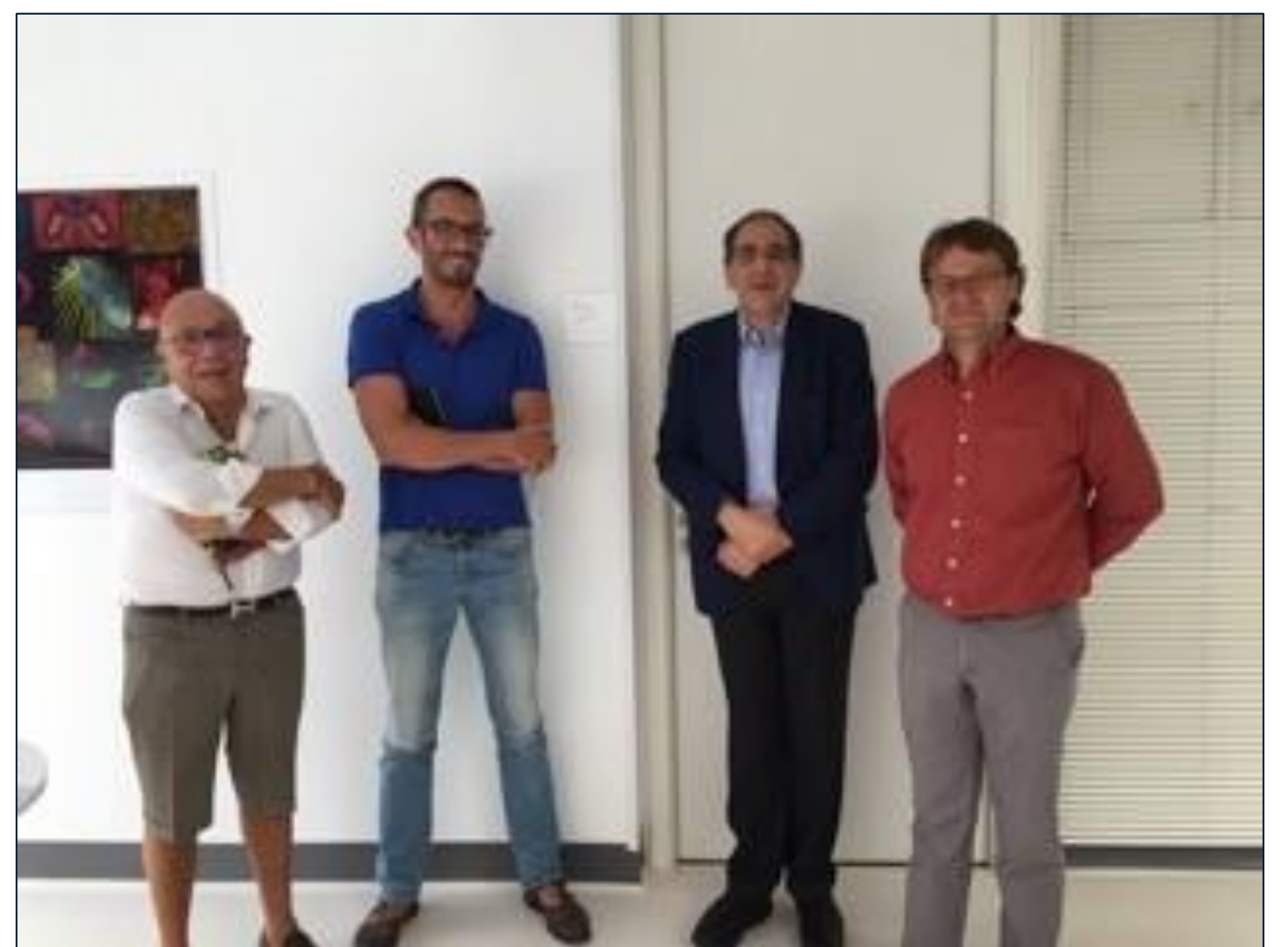
UM medical student Clay Bavinger performs research on retinal imaging at Hôpital Lariboisière in May 2016.
