

Clinical Excellence & Professionalism Award

PURPOSE

This award recognizes Adult and/or Pediatric Emergency Physician(s) who demonstrate unwavering dedication to achieving the highest standards in the delivery of emergency care and are looked upon as a role model by peers.

CRITERIA

The nominee must demonstrate exceptional commitment and dedication to emergency medicine emergency medicine. Attributes strongly considered include:

- Perception as a clinical role model
- Demonstrated commitment to patients and families
- Dedication to delivering empathetic, altruistic, patient-centered, and evidence-based care
- Consistent demonstration of excellent clinical, diagnostic, and technical skill
- Promotion of a culture of collaboration as well as continuing education
- Contribution towards achieving the future of emergency care

ELIGIBILITY

All Dept. of EM faculty, any rank, any track

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Any faculty member may nominate himself/herself or another faculty member by submitting the nomination form that can be found on the faculty awards program page, to Gina Mason Woods <u>gmasonwo@med.umich.edu</u>. All entries must be submitted by the deadline for consideration by the Department Awards Committee. The Awards Committee may choose to recognize more than one individual per year.

DETERMINATION

The Department Awards Committee will evaluate all entries. Recommendations will be subject to review by the Department Chair and Division Chiefs. The Committee reserves the right to make more than one nominee per award or no award if there are no nominees of sufficient merit. The award will be presented at the Annual Faculty Retreat.

AWARD

The Clinical Excellence Award features the recipient's name inscribed on a master plaque with the recipient receiving a framed award. The recipient will also be recognized on the Department website and social media channels as a part of the award recognition process.
