

Emergency Medicine Community Impact Award

PURPOSE

This award recognizes Michigan Medicine Department of Emergency or Pediatric Emergency Physician(s) who have made a substantial impact in the local, regional, national, or international community to improve health or education in a population.

ELIGIBILITY

All Dept. of EM faculty, any rank, any track are eligible

CRITERIA

The nominee must demonstrate exceptional commitment and dedication to emergency medicine/pediatric emergency medicine. Attributes strongly considered include:

- Demonstrated collaboration with community partners
- Creation or development of methods or tools to connect with community stakeholders or patient groups to facilitate acute health care needs.
- Establishment of emergency healthcare programs with significant community impact
- Evidence of teaching or mentoring at the community level
- Enduring products of scholarship resulting in significant community impact
- Contributions to health policy or services that affect outcomes of Michigan citizens within local organizations, hospitals or government.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Any faculty member may nominate himself/herself or another faculty member by submitting the nomination form that can be found on the faculty awards program page, to Gina Mason Woods gmasonwo@med.umich.edu. All entries must be submitted by the deadline for consideration by the Department Awards Committee. The Awards Committee may choose to recognize more than one individual per year.

DETERMINATION

The Department Awards Committee will evaluate all entries. Recommendations will be subject to review by the Department Chair and Division Chiefs. The Committee reserves the right to make more than one nominee per award or no award if there are no nominees of sufficient merit. The award will be presented at the Annual Faculty Retreat.

AWARD

The Emergency Medicine Community Impact Award features the recipient's name inscribed on a master plaque with the recipient receiving a framed award. The recipient will also be recognized on the Department website and social media channels as a part of the award recognition process.
