

Emergency Medicine Diversity, Equity, Inclusion Champion Award

PURPOSE

This award recognizes Michigan Medicine Department of Emergency or Pediatric Emergency Physician(s) who demonstrate significant commitment to fostering diversity, equity, and inclusion within our department, at the University of Michigan, and/or in the community.

CRITERIA

The nominee must demonstrate exceptional commitment and dedication to emergency medicine/pediatric emergency medicine. Attributes strongly considered include:

- Overall commitment to diversity in service, teaching, and scholarship
- Creation of and/or participation in programs that promote a more equitable and inclusive climate within the department, University, or community
- Efforts to recruit, retain, and develop a diverse community of trainees, staff, and faculty within EM/PEM
- Use of scholarly and/or creative work to enhance the success of students, faculty, and staff of diverse backgrounds

ELIGIBILITY

All Dept. of EM faculty, any rank, any track are eligible

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Any faculty member may nominate himself/herself or another faculty member by submitting the nomination form that can be found on the faculty awards program page, to Gina Mason Woods gmasonwo@med.umich.edu. All entries must be submitted by the deadline for consideration by the Department Awards Committee. The Awards Committee may choose to recognize more than one individual per year.

DETERMINATION

The Department Awards Committee will evaluate all entries. Recommendations will be subject to review by the Department Chair and Division Chiefs. The Committee reserves the right to make more than one nominee per award or no award if there are no nominees of sufficient merit. The award will be presented at the Annual Faculty Retreat.

AWARD

Emergency Medicine Diversity, Equity, Inclusion Champion Award features the recipient's name inscribed on a master plaque with the recipient receiving a framed award. The recipient will also be recognized on the Department website and social media channels as a part of the award recognition process.
