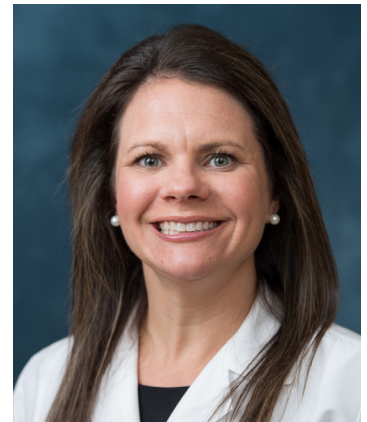
4th-Year Advanced Inflammatory Bowel Disease Fellowship

The Advanced IBD Fellowship is a 1-year training program for candidates who have completed a 3-year ABIM-certified Gastroenterology Fellowship.

The objective of the Advanced IBD Fellowship is to provide outstanding clinical and research training so that candidates can become independent IBD specialists. On completion of the program, the fellow will be competent in the evaluation and management of complex patients with ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease. There will be a focus on the indications for diagnosis, the indications for endoscopy and diagnostic imaging, the indications for medical therapy and monitoring in therapy, and the indications for surgical management and post-operative management, as well as the management of IBD in multidisciplinary setting (nutrition, surgery, psychosocial).

Candidates apply for either the Clinical Track or the Research Track, which has 50% IBD clinical time.
