

Robert Quinn is Professor Emeritus of Management and Organizations at the University of Michigan Ross School of Business, and the co-found and co-director of the Center for Positive Organizations. He has spent the last 40 years doing research, publishing, teaching, consulting, and speaking to more than half of the Fortune 500. His research and teaching interests focus on leadership, organization change, and effectiveness. He has published 18 books on these subjects. Dr. Quinn translates deep concepts into useable tools for sustained organizational change.
