1919 The Origin

The history of the Urology Department began on September 26, 1919 when Dean Victor Vaughan recommended the regents appoint Hugh Cabot “full-time Professor of Surgery.” In the subsequent 11 years, Cabot reshaped medical school and made Ann Arbor “an epicenter for medical education, residency training, and clinical practice especially so in all arenas of urology.” He established the foundation for Reed Nesbit to continue his legacy (excerpt from *Urology at Michigan - The Origin Story* in press).


