## Clinical Track Scholarly Contribution

### Clinician-Individualized Portfolio: an opportunity for the faculty member and chair/section/division chief to develop a pathway combining features of the multiple pathways noted above with clearly articulated goals and metrics.

My early career as a clinician-scholar focused on scholarship at the pre-doctoral and graduate levels, helping develop and maintain the first family medicine required clerkship at our institution, educational curriculum for clinical assessment at the medical school, and education curriculum used by family medicine residents nationally while maintaining excellent clinical care for my patients. My leadership skills are demonstrated by my 20+ year tenure as medical director of a clinic that met the greatest number of institutional and healthcare system's measured metrics for population health over all other ambulatory clinics in our institution for the past two years. I serve on several appointed and elected bodies in academic and public immunization circles: within our institution I co-chair the Immunization Committee. At the state level, I serve as the Michigan Academy of Family Physicians' liaison to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. I help shape national immunization recommendations and guidelines as the American Academy of Family Physicians' Liaison to the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and three CDC ACIP immunization working groups. I am an active reviewer for several prominent medical journals and have provided expertise in consultation for several regional and national immunization groups including the National Foundation for Infectious Diseases with numerous invitations to speak nationally on immunization topics. Publication and research highlights include authorship of several book chapters, a text on vaccines, immunization guidelines and applied evidence reviews, leadership in a multi-university grant-funded vaccine educational project, and ongoing grant-funded research with the Division of Nephrology in the Department of Internal Medicine and the UM School of Pharmacy.
