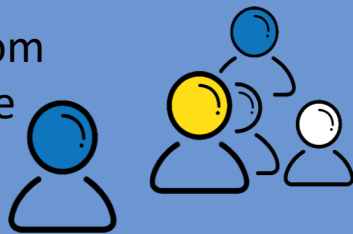


# Diversity in Medicine Conference

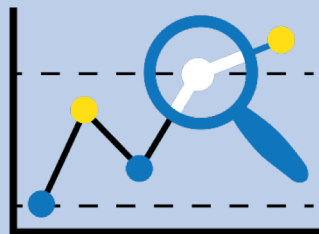
